The Southwestern Pennsylvania Juried Art Exhibition was initiated in 1996 in response to the Greensburg Area Cultural Council's mission to support visual artists in our area. Staff members of the Council met with community volunteers from government, business, education, health-care and the arts to build a structure that would reflect the interest of the community. Following standards of quality exhibitions throughout the nation, the first exhibition was held at the Westmoreland Museum of American Art in Greensburg, PA; other sites have included Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art in Ligonier, the St. Vincent College Gallery of Art in Latrobe, Seton Hill University and Indiana University of Pennsylvania. The exhibition continues to grow in response to artists' needs, becoming the prestigious exhibition it is today. This year the Council celebrates its 14th Anniversary of the Annual Regional Juried Exhibition.

In painting, if someone offered a landscape and a still life I was inclined to take the landscape, thinking of the overall exhibit as a showcase of the beauty of the region.

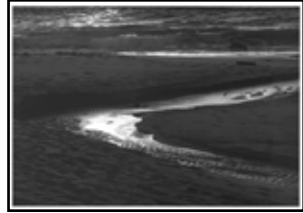
There was one limitation I did give myself and that was to accept only one piece from each artist. I wanted to be as inclusive as I could of both artists and styles of work.
